Smoking and Cannabis Rule

Definitions:

<u>Cannabis Smoking:</u> Smoking of cannabis includes the inhaling, breathing, carrying, or possession of any lighted product containing cannabis and includes vaping with electronic cigarettes or any other activities that create smoke.

Cannabis Growing: Cultivating of cannabis/marijuana plants.

Rules:

Cannabis Smoking

Smoking of cannabis is not permitted in, on, or around any part of the common elements, including all exclusive-use common elements.

Smoking of cannabis is permitted in your own unit, however, it is the sole responsibility of the owner to ensure that smoke does not interfere unduly on other owners.

Cannabis Growing

Growing or cultivating of cannabis plants is not permitted in, on, or around any part of the common elements, including all exclusive use common elements and inside the units.

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Cannabis Growing

Growing or cultivating of cannabis plants is not permitted in, on, or around any part of the common elements, including all exclusive-use common elements and inside the units.

Ottawa Carleton Standard Condominium Corporation No. 769 Amendment to Cannabis Rule

Effective November 15, 2018

Dear Owners of Riverside Gate II,

On September 14, 2018 a rule was sent to all owners regarding cannabis and is attached as a reminder. This rule remains in effect with one amendment.

The recent survey sent to owners received a 90% response. It was clear that majority of owners were not in favour of smoking cannabis in the units. The September 14, 2018 rule allows smoking of cannabis in units and therefore we have created an amendment to the existing rule, which prohibits smoking cannabis in the units.

Any owner has the right to requisition a meeting in accordance with Section 46 of the Condominium Act (S.O. 1998, Chapter 19) if s/he wishes to challenge these rules. 15% owners must wish to reverse the rule in writing. If the corporation receives 15% of owners wishing to reverse the rule, a meeting of the owners will be held to vote on the rule. Management must receive such a request in writing, before the effective date of the new rule, which is November 15, 2018.
