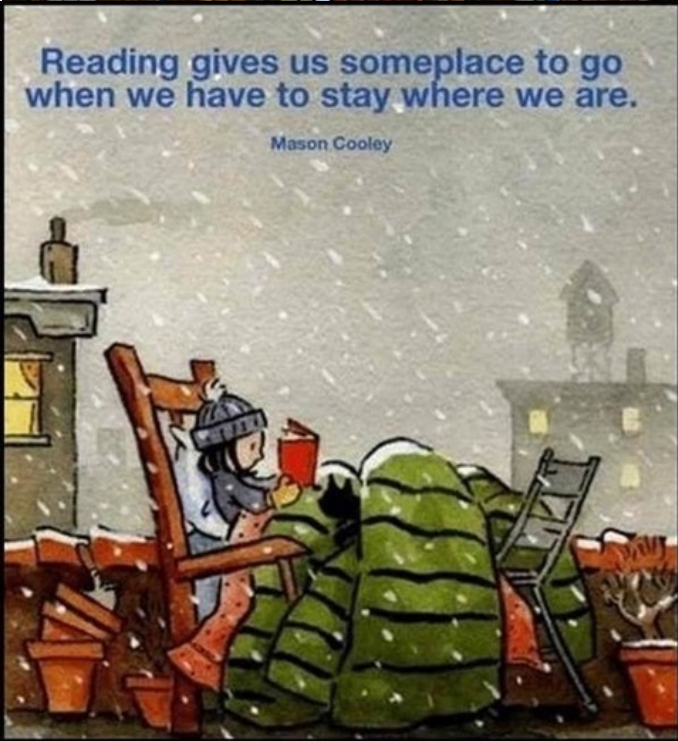

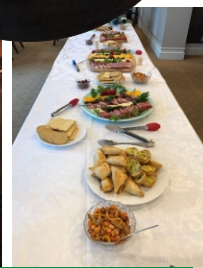
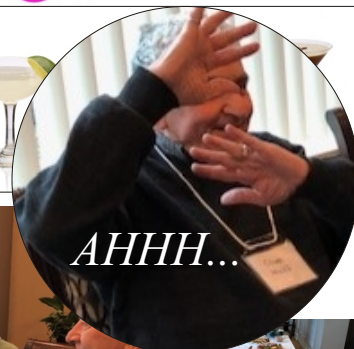
When owners drop off new donations, the first order of business is place the books in the New Arrivals section. New Arrivals are displayed in the bookcase to the immediate right, as you step into the library, and will stay there for a week or so. Afterward, they will be placed in the appropriate section based on the subject matter.

Even though the majority of books are English language fiction, there is also a small selection of fiction "en français". The Library also has a variety of sections including, but not limited to, periodicals, newspapers, jigsaw puzzles, children's books, art, biographies and history books, as well as dictionaries.

The volunteers purge the inventory of duplicates and damaged or dated items, such as magazines and periodicals. The volunteers strive to find new homes for our surplus inventory be it book sales, second hand stores, or known charities.

## WHOM TO CALL
